- 2. Principal / Assistant Principal's Items
 - Behavior and Bullying Presentation (Ms. Byrom)
 - Ms. Byrom presented slides regarding student discipline at CES
 - Reviewed the HCPSS Suspension data which reflects a decline for the year
 - Reviewed HCPSS Student Code of Conduct, levels of behavior and disciplinary action (Levels 1-5)
 - Reviewed the CES Communication form. Three levels of written communication: Communication Form, Incident Report/Staff Documentation, Office Disciplinary Report
 - Both the Incident Report (completed by staff) and the Office Disciplinary Report (only completed by administration) are placed in the student's file
 - 2. Incident Report/Staff Documentation goes to MSDE
 - Parents asked questions and expressed a desire for more communication coming home regarding classroom wide incidents such as generic email to inform parents that something has occurred in school or on the bus
 - Parents asked Ms. Byrom for more transparency
 - Ms. Byrom clarified what is and isn't considered bullying. She also reviewed the bullying form that goes to MSDE. Whether it has been deemed bullying or not, the parent will receive a letter that advises what will take place to help remedy
 - Reviewed Positive Behavioral Supports and Interventions (Cougar Coupons for good behavior); ALS students earn Cougar Coupons as well
